Score	Description
2	The student identifies two things Mr. Nobody would say to the author if he could talk. A possible response may include, but is not limited to, the following: I did not put fingerprints on the door. I should not be blamed for everything that goes wrong because children often do those things.
1	The student identifies one thing Mr. Nobody would say to the author if he could talk.
0	The student does not identify anything Mr. Nobody would say to the author if he could talk, and does not justify the answer choice OR the response is either incorrect or irrelevant.
