Dear Secretary Ruskowski:

In accordance with NMSA 22-15-8, the Instructional Material Bureau has conducted the 2017 Summer Review Institute for grades K–12 health materials for adoption as core basal (CB). There were no physical education materials submitted for review by publishers. The reviews were conducted at the institute held in Santa Fe at the New Mexico State Capitol, from June 5 through June 9, 2017. The reviewers were levels II and III teachers from districts across the state.


Of the 15 titles submitted for review at the summer institute, 14 have been recommended for adoption as CB, and 1 has been recommended for adoption as supplementary (SU). The 14 titles that have been recommended as CB align—at 90 percent or better—with New Mexico academic content and performance standards and other relevant criteria. Materials recommended as CB include student and teacher editions, student workbooks, and bundles that consist of the student edition and/or teacher edition of a title. Materials recommended as SU were either reviewed—but did not align with the standards at 90 percent or better, were not submitted for review by the publisher, or were classified as ancillary materials. Materials may be print, digital, or both.


At the request of the Blended Learning Bureau Director and the sanction of the Instructional Material Bureau Chief, the IdealNM health material was reviewed as CB and is included in this report. The IdealNM material will not be included on the multiple list at this time; however, it can be added if deemed necessary.
