

EARLY CHILDHOOD, B- 3

- ✓ Bachelor's Degree (earned from a regionally accredited college/university)

AND

- ✓ Minimum of 36 – 42 semester hours in an Early Childhood Education program including 18 - 30 semester credits of practicum and field experience to include student teaching in one of the following age ranges: B-3, 3-5 or 5- 8

AND

- ✓ 6 semester hours of credit in the teaching of reading for those who first entered any college or university on or after August 1, 2001

AND

- ✓ 150 contact hour practicum and/or supervised field experience at a developmental stage other than what was selected for student teaching

OR

- ✓ 3 years of verified work experience with at least 2 of the age ranges listed above from an accredited center

AND

- ✓ Passage of the New Mexico Teacher Assessments (NMTA)
 - Basic Skills
 - Teacher Competency, Early Childhood

OR

- ✓ Possess a certificate issued by the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards
