AND

- ✓ Possess a Registered Nurse license issued by the NM Board of Nursing

- SUPERVISORY LEVEL (703)

- ✓ Master's Degree in Nursing (earned from a regionally accredited college/university or from an institution accredited by the National League of Nursing)

OR

- ✓ Master's Degree in a Health Related Field (earned from a regionally accredited college/university or from an institution accredited by the National League of Nursing)

AND

- ✓ Possess a Registered Nurse license issued by the NM Board of Nursing

OR

- ✓ Possess an RN license issued by another state participating in the compact between states
