

FAMILY & CONSUMER SCIENCE

- ✓ Beginning teachers adding the endorsement to an initial license must satisfy the requirements for the license which include 24-36 semester hours in family & consumer science and pass the Content Knowledge Assessment (CKA) in Family & Consumer Science.

- ✓ Teachers seeking to add the endorsement to an existing NM teaching license of any level can either:
 - Pass the CKA in Family & Consumer Science; predecessor or comparable exam

 - OR**

 - Earn 24-36 semester hours of credit in family & consumer science (12 of the hours must be upper division credit if adding the endorsement to a secondary or pre k-12 specialty license).

 - OR**

 - Be certified by the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards in family & consumer science.
