SUBJECT: Reimbursement Rates for SY 2010-2011

As published in the Federal Register, Reimbursement Rates dated July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 are attached. The reimbursement rates are for the National School Lunch, School Breakfast, Special Milk, and After School Snack Programs.

*The changes in the national average payment rates for schools and residential child care institutions for the period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 reflect a 1.14 percent increase in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers during the 12-month period May 2009 to May 2010 (from a level of 223.023 in May 2009 as previously published in the **Federal Register** to 225.573 in May 2010). Adjustments to the national average payment rates for all lunches served under the National School Lunch Program, breakfasts served under the School Breakfast Program, and afterschool snacks served under the National School Lunch Program are rounded down to the nearest whole cent.*

Commodity/Food Distribution: Notice is hereby given that the national average minimum value of donated foods, or cash in lieu thereof, per lunch under the NSLP (7 CFR part 210) and per lunch and supper under the CACFP (7 CFR part 226) shall be 20.25 cents for the period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This is an increase of .75 cents from the school year 2010 (July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010) rate. Please contact our office if you have questions (505) 827-1821.
