Note for Part B. Budget Forms: Total funds received are based on formula driven calculations applied by the Federal Office of Vocational and Adult Education (OVAE). Allocation to the State is made only after an approved State Plan is submitted to OVAE, reviewed by Federal monitors, and subsequently approved by OVAE.

Note for Part C. *Accountability Forms:* the State must submit content within these forms that is subject to guidance from OVAE. Additionally, the State is required to adapt student definitions and identified performance measure levels per communication with OVAE throughout the 5-year plan period. The purpose of the performance measures is to have a gauge to measure improvement.
