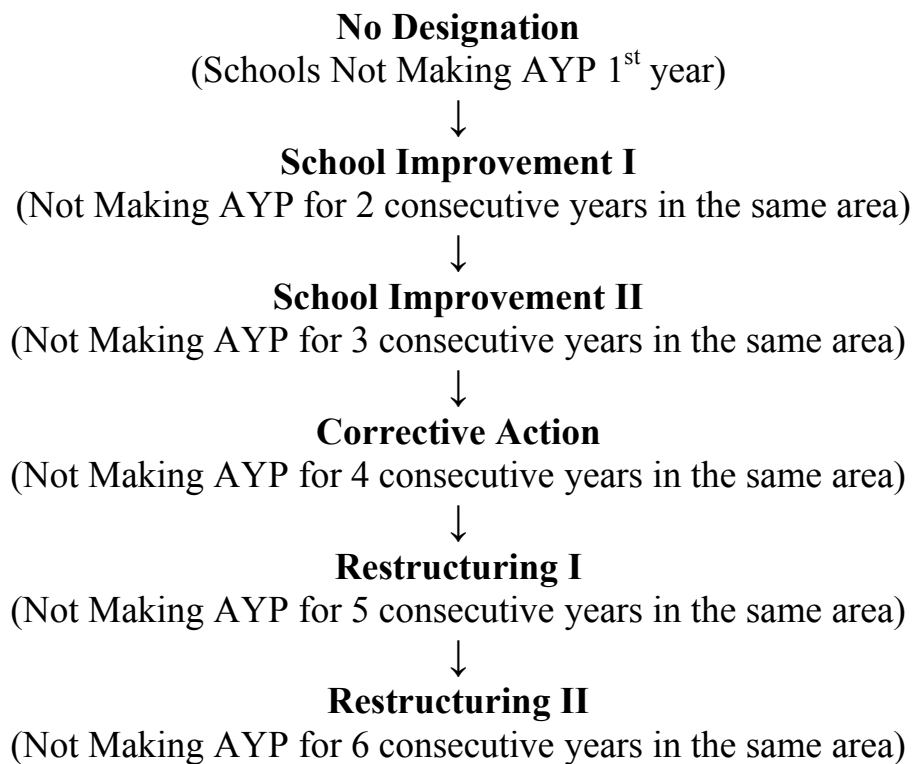

NEW MEXICO SCHOOL REFORM ACT & NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT CYCLE

Listed below are the School Reform Act (SRA) and No Child Left Behind (NCLB) designations for schools that fail to make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for two (2) consecutive years in the same area

New Mexico School Reform Act (SRA)/ No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Designations
“AYP Not Met” in same subject, or other (Attendance, Graduation) for two (2) consecutive years in the same area



Entering the cycle: Schools will receive a SRA/NCLB designation of School Improvement I only after failing to meet AYP for two (2) consecutive years in the same area.

Delay provision: Schools with a SRA/NCLB designation that meet AYP in the year following a “designation” remain in the same designation with “delay” for that year.

Exiting the cycle: Schools with a SRA/NCLB designation that make AYP for two consecutive years in the same area have “No Designation”.

Proficiency Goal: 100% of students will be “proficient” by the 2013-2014 school year.
