# ECO

- The ECO is an assessment for all 3y and 4y students.
- Data is collected and reported to OSEP
- Entry and Progress data are collected

# Measures:

- Percent of preschool children with IEPs who demonstrate improved:

Positive social-emotional skills

Acquisition and use of knowledge and skills

Use of appropriate behaviors to meet their needs

# Entry Data

- Done within 30 days of program entry.  
**Only done once.**
- Administer the Brigance, Creative Curriculum, Work Sampling, or an approved petitioned assessment

# Entry Data

- Convert the results to the Child Outcome Summary Form (COSF)
- Convert the 1-7 COSF scores to the A-E OSEP scores
- Can enter throughout the year as new students enter the program

# Progress Data

- Done annually on every 3y & 4y student who has an IEP
- Use A-E progress statements to report this into STARS

# Progress Data

- Data will be extracted between 120<sup>th</sup> day and EOY reporting periods
- Progress data is for those who have been in program for at least 6 months
- REC 4 will convert data into charts and graphs for reporting purposes
